AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities.

Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

ENTRY FEES

Make checks payable to the trial secretary Sheryl Harnames and mail to 6537 W. 4600 S. Hooper, UT 84315. ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. PST, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Photocopies or images of paper entries without the agreement and information completed do not meet AKC requirements and are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. 'Exhibition Only' or conditional entries will not be permitted. Be sure to allow delivery time to reach destination before closing.

OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES include AKC recording and service fee of \$4.50 for each entry. PVOC shall assume the responsibility of collecting all event recording and service fees for the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Obedience entries may close early if time limits are reached before closing date.

Separate fee for same dog, same day. When a dog is entered in more than one class the highest priced class is considered the first entry.

First OBEDIENCE Titling class entry of each dog same day.....\$32.00

Additional OBEDIENCE Titling class entry of same dog, same day.....\$26.00

Entries overpaid by \$10 or less will not be issued a refund.

RALLY ENTRY FEES include AKC recording and service fee of \$4.50 for each entry. PVOC shall assume the responsibility of collecting all event service fees for the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Rally entries may close early if time limits are reached before closing date.

Separate fee for same dog, same day. When a dog is entered in more than one class the highest priced class is considered the first entry.

First RALLY entry of same dog, same day.....\$32.00

Additional Rally entry of same dog, same day.....\$26.00

Entries overpaid by \$10 or less will not be issued a refund.

Online entries are available. Online entry processing fees for each event are \$3.00 for the first entry same dog, same day; \$1.00 for each additional entry same dog, same day.

Only entered dogs are allowed at these trials. No dog under 6 months of age may compete. Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

Wait-listed entries must be received by the trial secretary prior to closing date and will be first received entry method. (Chapter 1, Section 27).

A **wait list** will be maintained first received entry method in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day. The full entry fee will be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email prior to close of entries.

OBEDIENCE and RALLY ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT WHERE APPLICABLE. As allowed by January 1, 2009, rule, all obedience/Rally classes that have jumps will be judged in jump height order. The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate special-needs handlers.

TRANSFERS FOR OBEDIENCE and RALLY. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. (When a club does not allow transfers, refer to Section 16b Entry of Ineligible Dog). The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer/Move up form is available from the Trial Secretary jumpinterriers@gmail.com or online at <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/masterform.cfm>. Please be courteous and complete transfer form as soon as possible.

Non-qualifying raffle for \$30.00 obedience and \$30.00 for rally will be held on Friday Oct 23, and Saturday, Oct 24, 2026. All non-qualifying dogs entered in obedience and rally on Friday and Saturday are invited to participate. Be sure to register at the trial trophy table. **MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules and regulations of Petrack Park and/or local restriction. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged (AKC leash restrictions March 2009). Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Event Committee. The Event Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the trial.

Pahrump Valley Obedience Club of Nevada Inc., officers, Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property whether the result of accident or other cause and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times and children are under the care, custody and control of their parent(s) or guardian at all times.

The trial site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 a.m. each trial day. Dogs must be removed DAILY from the trial site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class. Setups may be left overnight but PVOC, Trial Secretary, Pahrump City or Petrack Park will not be responsible for lost or stolen or damaged items.

Bitches in season are strictly prohibited on the show grounds.

Refund of entry fees for bitches entered that are in season the day of this trial may be obtained provided a request in writing is received by the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Obedience Regulations Chapter 2, Section 26, — “There will be no intensive or abusive training of dogs on the grounds or premises at an AKC licensed or member obedience trial or sanctioned match.” This rule will be strictly enforced; violators will be subject to a Trial Committee hearing. Special training devices that are used to control and train dogs, including but not limited to: collars with prongs, electric collars used with transmitters, muzzles, and head collars may not be used on dogs at AKC Events, except as allowed in the AKC rules, regulations, and policies.

Double handling will not be permitted at these trials. Attempts to do so will be subject to actions by the Event Class Judge and/or the Event Committee.

Entries will not be accepted without correct fees or agreement signature on the back of the entry form. Incorrect amounts of \$10.00 and under will not be refunded.

Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date and time. Anyone wishing to withdraw entries must do so in writing prior to the closing date and time.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Entries will be acknowledged no later than after entries close with an entry acknowledgement and judging program mailed to email or home address on entry (if you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgement of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry, trial name and Agent's correct email address for this courtesy.) Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable amount of time please notify the Trial Secretary at jumpinterriers@gmail.com.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Trials Premium List.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. In the event of a returned check, a replacement check will not be acceptable and guaranteed funds will be required. Guaranteed funds are defined as Money Order, Cashier's Check, or Cash. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the trial location of Petrack Park.

Flash photography is not permitted.

Social distancing will be conducted in accordance with current guidelines required or recommended by local health departments.
